Pandemic Plan Preventing the Spread of COVID-19

OPERATING UNDER COVID 19 "STATE OF EMERGENCY" NB

What the Regulation require:

Any and all Staff and Campers having returned from Domestic and International travel must self-isolate for a minimum 14 days.

Self Assess for symptoms of Covid -19 are to be done each morning by Staff and Campers Parent/Gardian.

Any Staff or Campers showing any symptoms must report to 811 immediately. (Symptoms include Fever (signs of a fever), Runny nose , Headache, New onset of cough or exacerbation of chronic cough, Sore throat, New onset of fatigue, New onset of muscle pain, Loss of taste or smell, Diarrhea

OR

A child displaying purple fingers or toes even as the only symptom

If either of the above criteria is met, those who are sick must stay home, contact 811, and cannot return until fully recovered. If tested, Public Health will inform the individual or parent (when a child is involved) when isolation may be lifted.

Note: Children or staff who have been identified as having seasonal allergies or who suffer from chronic runny nose/nasal congestion are not required to be excluded.

If any Staff or Camper becomes ill while at camp, they must immediately go to the isolation area until they can be picked up. If a camper becomes ill they and supervising staff member will be required to wear a face mask and maintain 2 meter distance in the isolation area until the parent/guardian arrives for pick up. Parent/Guardian must have child tested for Covid 19. Negative test results or a 2 week isolation period are mandatory before Staff or Camper may return to camp.

Signs must be placed in various locations through out the camp reminding Staff and Campers to wash their hands frequently with soap and water or hand sanitizers.(with at least 60% alcohol)

Limit contact with others when at home and or at work.

Refrain from touching their eyes, nose, and mouth. Must wash after having done so. Cough into elbow or Kleenex to lesson spread. Clean high-touch surface areas and objects often.

Avoid close contact with other group by a distance of 2 meters.

Proper hand washing by Staff and Campers.

Proper sanitizing of Camp facilities and washrooms twice day.
